**Note:** Candidate No. 1 is required to register for the remedial English courses.

Candidate No. 1 is further required to submit one of the following scores prior to graduation from the program.

At least 79 for TOEFL iBT or

At least 550 for TOEFL ITP or

At least 6.5 for IELTS or

At least 650 for NIDA EPT (English Proficiency Test)

Candidate No. 1 should enroll in the course that increases knowledge for taking a Qualifying Exam as an audit base on adviser recommendation.

## 1. Documents for Registration

### 1.2 Official transcripts (2 copies each for both bachelor's and master's degree).

### 1.3 House registration certificate (1 copies).

### 1.4 National ID Card (2 copies).

### 1.5 Medical certificate issued by a physician or a medically qualified healthcare provider which certifies that you are free of contagious diseases or other serious health conditions that can interfere with your study. This medical certificate can be requested at any private or public hospitals and clinics and must be valid within one month only (1 copy).

### 1.6 Two photographs (1" Size, not wearing academic gown).

### 1.7 Evidence of any change of name, e.g., Marriage Certificate (2 copies).

### 1.8 Passport / VISA (international student only) (2 copies).

### 1.9 Student Card Form (1 copy). Candidates can download from <http://edserv.nida.ac.th/th/student/freshman> (Don't have to fill the student ID section)

### 1.10 Letter of consent to disclose information to a third party (2 copies). Candidates can download from <https://edserv.nida.ac.th/student/freshman>

N.B. (i) All photocopies of documents must be signed by the applicant (certified copy).

(ii) Students cannot register in more than one program at NIDA. If they are current students in any program at NIDA, their registration in the new program shall be cancelled.

NIDA reserves the right to examine documents and qualifications of an applicant at any time. If it is found that an applicant does not meet the required qualifications, the announcement of acceptance of that person shall be cancelled.

**Remark:** Non-Thai students are obligated to apply for health insurance according to the regulation of the institute otherwise the registration will be invalid.

**23<sup>rd</sup> June 2025:** NIDA will send out an email on new student registration instruction to students’ email given in the authentication process above. Students can also download student manual at <https://edserv.nida.ac.th/student/handle-student/>

**24<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025:** Students register their personal data and enroll in courses by logging in to <http://reg.nida.ac.th/> (Username and Password for logging in is students’ ID number e.g., 681xxxxxxx)

#### Payment for Student Registration

**24<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025:** Applicants with the registration form can pay the registration fee at Bangkok Bank or Kasikorn Bank or Krungsri Bank or Counter Service. If the payment has not been made by **30<sup>th</sup> June 2025**, applicants shall be automatically dropped from registration.

#### 4. First day of classes

Classes will begin on 9<sup>th</sup> August 2025. Applicants who are on leave for study must provide a letter that confirms their leave from his/her employer by 9<sup>th</sup> August 2025, otherwise the registration shall be incomplete.

#### 5. Personal Data Protection

According to the Personal Data Protection Act, B.E. 2562 (2019), the Institute must have the right to collect, use and/or disclose personal data of the selected applicants for the purpose of educational implementation in accordance with duty and authority of the Institute along with personal data protection.
